#### **BURGLARY**


During the month of September Fullwell Ward suffered with 5 residential burglaries and 4 attempts (no access was gained).

This dramatic fall in burglary is as a direct result of targeted policing by SNT officers in conjunction with other enforcement units. We have arranged and conducted proactive policing operations working hand in hand with Essex Police in order to achieve this. We are continually providing residents with appropriate crime prevention advice and have arranged local initiatives in order to distribute literature and associated items. We would also like to thank the members of the local neighbourhood watch schemes whose members continue to provide both excellent and useful information to police.

## **ARRESTS + OTHER MATTERS**

Police Officers from Fullwell SNT have arrested **3** people during the month of September for offences such as Arson, Possession of Drugs and assault.

We have also issued **10** people with official warnings in relation to their possession of Cannabis. A further **6** people committing various offences were issued with penalty notices for £200.00, £80.00 and £30.00. We are continuing to



stop, and where able Search those persons we believe are within Fullwell Ward intending to commit crime.

## **OLDER PEOPLES DAY**

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of September, Fullwell SNT officers attended Fullwell Cross Library in order to take part in "Older Peoples Week". Officers spent 4hrs at the location, met with those who attended, provided crime prevention advice, and distributed low energy light bulbs, purse security lanyards and personal safety leaflets.
